Jasmin Battista, born 1975, is an Official of the European Commission working in DG Competition, Antitrust energy unit, where she identifies and addresses key obstacles along supply chain to integrated and competitive gas and electricity markets by bringing leading cases i.e. on cartel cases. Before she worked as a legal secretary (Référéndaire) at the Court of First Instance (CFI) in Luxembourg initially for the President of the CFI, Judge Vesterdorf, then with judge Moavero Milanesi. Her principal activities involved drafting preliminary reports, reports for the hearing, draft judgments in EC law cases and horizontal tasks. In particular she dealt with a high profile abuse of dominant position case, State aid, trade marks, liability and cases in appeal of judgments of the Civil Service Tribunal. Before joining the CFI, she worked for 3 years (2002-2005) as a case handler and then in the coordination unit in the field of the EC State aid law for DG Competition of the European Commission. This job was preceded by working three years in leading law firms in Brussels, i.e. Coudert Brothers, specialised in competition, agricultural and trade law. In the last few years Jasmin Battista has participated as a speaker at numerous conferences in the field of EU law, International labour law, competition and state aid law, and has also acted as a lecturer at different university and postgraduate programmes.
