Peter Pagh is 55 years old and has since 1999 been professor in Environmental Law at the University of Copenhagen. Pagh was president of student organisation from 1972-1974 and travel secretary from 1974-1976. From 1976 to 1986 Pagh was constructing worker. In 1986 Pagh started studying at the Law Faculty of University of Copenhagen and finished in 1990 with a master degree of law. The same year Pagh published his first book on EC Environmental Law besides being a lawyer at a law firm and teaching at the law faculty in EC law and international law. In 1991 Pagh started the first course at the law faculty on EC environmental law and in 1992 Pagh started a senior research scholarship and stayed at Duke University in US from 1992-1993. In 1995 Pagh was appointed as associated professor in civil law. In January 1999 Pagh defended his thesis on environmental liability and become doctor juris. From 1999 to the end of 2002 Pagh was director of the legal institute C at the Faculty. In September 1999 Pagh was appointed professor of Environmental Law at the Law Faculty at the University of Copenhagen. In year 2007 Pagh was appointed as temporary high court judge and has after returning to the University been arbitration judge on a temporary basis. Pagh has written books on EU-Environmental Law, on EU-Law on public procurement and published a comprehensive study comparing US-Environmental Law with EU respectively Danish Environmental Law. Since 1996 Pagh has been one of the editors at the Danish magazine on environmental case-law and has since 2003 been the responsible editor of the magazine. Pagh has published 14 books and more than 190 of articles in legal magazines, mainly on environmental law subjects and EC-law - see publication list. Pagh is member of the Avosetta group and several other international networks. In 2003 Pagh was appointed as one of the Roster of Experts under the Cartagena Protocol adopted under the Biodiversity Convention. From 1995 to 1999, Pagh was responsible for a basic course on EU Environmental Law and on EU Waste Law offered for lawyers and senior officers in the Member States and organised by the European Academy in Trier. In 2000



Pagh developed a more comprehensive course on EU Environmental Law addressed for senior officers in the State of transition. Pagh has been involved in several studies for the EC Commission including two of the last studies on environmental crime and a study on the Trans-European Network.
